ROGER GFRÖRER


On a ski safari round the world

Even as a child, Roger Gfrörer felt a deep sense of connection with the mountains and skiing. Over time, this turned into an ambition to explore every skiing area of the world.

He has already travelled to 605 skiing areas in 22 countries and been on 5421 ski lifts.

We invited the globetrotting skier to try the Sunstar Ski Safari in Grindelwald and Wengen and took the opportunity to talk to him about his life and his exciting adventures.

“Where other people hang up pictures, I have maps of the world on the walls in my flat. Next to them are my skis, because I don’t keep them stashed away in the cellar.”

The maps of the world are dotted with numerous green and red pins. The green pins show the snow-covered parts of the world that Roger Gfrörer has already visited. The areas marked in red remain to be explored by him.

“I like the world when it’s white. I’m just crazy about the mountains, they give you a new perspective. It’s a good thing there are so many of them.” Roger is a likeable man in his late 40s who can still vividly recall how, as a child, he would always cry his eyes out when the family skiing holiday came to an end. The young Roger’s first experiences on the ski slopes were in Leysin. He clearly

remembers going up a mountain between his father’s legs on a ski lift in 1975. Since then, the number of green pins on his maps of the world has increased rapidly.

“In July 2009, I went on my first exotic skiing adventure to Australia. When I left the house, with my skis under my arm, it was 30°. People gave me some strange looks. I was actually asking myself the same question, what on earth am I doing...?!” However, it soon turned out that the Australians are pretty keen on skiing. Everyone talks to everyone else on the chairlifts and so the globetrotting Roger discovered that Swiss ski resorts are held in the highest esteem by Australians. You can even go skiing with kangaroos: because some species can be found in mountainous regions, even at over 2100 metres, you may indeed see these cute creatures while you’re skiing. Oh, and if you drive beyond the snow line without chains, you have to pay a large fine. You can even hire those chains there!



Roger Gfrörer has also experienced some very tense moments on his travels: **"Argentina is by far the poorest country that I've ever been to. Everywhere there are policemen or members of the Argentinian National Security force standing around holding machine guns and checking cars and their occupants. It was all very uncomfortable for a laid-back tourist like me!"** However, as he began to tell us about the wonderful desert landscapes, the volcanic regions and the really high, snow-capped mountains, he became extremely enthusiastic. Despite the poverty, he found Bariloche to be a popular tourist hotspot. Nevertheless, compared with Australia, he found Argentina to be quite "empty".

"In terms of infrastructure, too, I'm always seeing new things." For example, in Chile there are the so-called slingshot ski lifts. These consist of two long frameworks, each with buttons for 6 to 8 people to sit on – a perfect design for the very steep slopes there. In New Zealand they generally use rope tow lifts, similar to those used on our nursery slopes. It's just that, there, they are extremely fast and



steep. To secure yourself, you wear a kind of climbing harness with carabiner hooks that you fasten round the rope. In North America, our adventurer has even visited some skiing areas that have been awarded a quality mark. For example, the "Green Label" mark for sustainable electricity production.

Talking of "sustainability", we ask Roger Gfrörer how it sits with his environmental conscience when he regularly goes jetting round the world. He admits that he hasn't resolved that issue yet. Whenever possible, he tries to combine his business trips with his private interests. He also takes the question of offsetting CO₂ emissions very seriously.

To round off our two-day ski safari together in the Bernese Oberland, we ask Roger Gfrörer what he thinks of the skiing areas in Grindelwald and Wengen: **"The mountain scenery is stunning, the summits feel close enough to touch. I've never experienced that proximity before. The slopes are very varied, some of them quite steep. For me, the First area is ideal for Telemark skiing – I can really soak up the atmosphere there and enjoy myself!"**

Here's a quick summary of the work that was carried out in spring/summer 2020 and forthcoming projects for autumn/winter 2020/21.


Looking back

The new wellness area in **Lenzerheide** opened just in time for the 2020 summer season. Following the second phase of refurbishment in the spring, it now has a gleaming up-to-date new look and is a most inviting place to relax in. In **Davos**, the 42 new Premium rooms and three suites were created as planned despite the difficult circumstances and the plumbing was also refurbished.

Looking ahead

Originally there were supposed to have been four new family rooms ready for the 2020 summer season in **Arosa**, but now these will be available for our guests young and old from the start of the 2020/21 winter season. The conversion of the adjacent "Casa Pia" building in **Piedmont** is still ongoing. By the spring of 2021, there will be an "osteria" here and 7 new rooms.

We would like to say a huge **thank you** to everyone involved in completing these big projects on time despite all the difficulties caused by COVID-19.

Marco Barbon, Member of the Management Board, is responsible for the "Facility Management" and "Sustainability" departments. The married father of adult twin daughters likes to indulge in his two hobbies of football and swimming. He has been working for Sunstar Hotels with great commitment since 1 March 2018 and the job is a good match for his love of cooking, red wine and "la bella Italia".

Why did you originally choose Sunstar to be your new employer?

I worked for Swissôtel for 37 years, for 32 of those in the same role. When Sunstar approached me to ask if I would like to become head of Facility Management, it sparked my interest straightaway. Firstly, it was a welcome opportunity to take on a new challenge, even at my age. Secondly, the idea appealed to me of working for a Swiss company with hotels in different parts of the Swiss mountains – and in the sun-blessed region of Ticino and in Piedmont, as well.

Nowadays, everyone talks about "Facility Management" or "FM".

What exactly does it mean?

It can also be called property management or buildings management. It's about managing properties and looking after buildings and their technical systems and installations. In relation to my own work, it means that I look after the various properties in their entirety – everything to do with maintenance, energy management, refurbishment and alterations.

Can you sum up your responsibilities in terms of sustainability?

There are many aspects to sustainability. One is to protect the natural environment, which we do by building sustainably and buying locally. Another thing is economic efficiency: achieving good economic

results safeguards the survival of our business. And one further important responsibility is social solidarity, i.e. being a fair employer and supporting people who are disadvantaged.

Is there one thing to which you attach particular importance in your work?

I always want to build to a high quality and as sustainably as possible. It may not always be the cheapest option, but in the long term it always pays off. We want our guests to feel at home in Sunstar hotels and enjoy a good experience so that they recommend us to other people.

How can guests recognise your work? Is there a particular quality or outstanding characteristic that is typical?

As Head of Facility Management, I try to do as much as I can with the financial resources available to me. My input can be seen particularly in sustainable renovation and alteration work.

What does the diversity of the Sunstar hotels mean to you in your work and what does it have to offer the guests?

Certainly, each hotel has its own special charm and character. That makes the work incredibly interesting, because you can't simply copy a job or a concept from one hotel to another. Guests may know

the name "Sunstar", but they will find something different at each hotel.

What do you look for when you stay in a hotel yourself? What makes a comfortable, memorable stay for you?

For me, friendly and helpful staff are very important. Being made to feel welcome. I also rate cleanliness, a good atmosphere, fine food and great wellness services very highly.

If you had a personal message for your guests, what would it be?

Don't just stick to one Sunstar hotel but visit all the hotels in our group. Experience the diversity of the alpine regions in the east and the west of the country. And if you like to head south, why not enjoy a trip along Lake Maggiore? Combine your visit to beautiful Brissago with some "dolce far niente..." in idyllic Piedmont. It's worth it!



When I opened my Christmas present from my daughter, I had to gulp: “A voucher for a snowshoe tour together”. With my level of fitness! It could hardly have been more embarrassing for me. Yet despite my initial stress, the outing turned out to be an unexpectedly enjoyable experience!



Oh no, how embarrassing!!! Wordlessly I look at the gift voucher that my student daughter has bought for me with her hard-earned money. I sit as if rooted to the sofa. ME and SNOWSHOE WALKING?!?! And now in particular, when I haven't done any exercise for months! Not to mention the excesses of the festive period when – if I'm quite honest – I still haven't managed to shift the extra kilos I put on last Christmas.

I find the idea of puffing along behind my ultra-fit daughter, wearing those bizarre snowshoes, utterly mortifying. But of course I don't let it show and I thank her warmly for the wonderful surprise. Secretly I'm just happy that the to(rt)ur(e) isn't for another three weeks. So I have time to gen up a bit on the Internet...



Snowshoe walking is really “in”.

I didn't realise that snowshoe walking is so popular nowadays. There are numerous mountain regions with well-marked snowshoe trails: from fairly flat to more challenging, the range of routes for every fitness level is quite extensive. If you can walk normally, you can walk with snowshoes – you don't need any lessons so there are no excuses! The question of what to wear is also really simple: it's best to wear warm, waterproof clothing on the layering principle. The kind of thing that would be suitable for skiing or cross-country skiing. Combined with leg warmers and hiking boots. Snowshoes and poles with snow baskets can be hired or bought – it's a good idea to seek advice from a specialist shop.

How nice that the sun is shining for our tour today! With plenty of sunscreen applied, sunglasses on our noses and a snack in our rucksack, off we tramp. We have chosen an easy beginners' route which is very clearly marked with flashes of coloured paint. Even though the walk takes us along relatively avalanche-free slopes, this morning we nevertheless quickly checked the latest avalanche report. If only there wasn't still the problem of my lack of fitness... The first few steps feel quite strange. I feel like a duck waddling through the snow.

But the knowledge that with snowshoes you can walk on deep snow without sinking down into it is fantastic! And instead of me having to puff along behind my daughter, suddenly we are gliding along through the idyllic winter landscape, side by side, smoothly and completely relaxed. The sky is as blue as can be and the snow crystals glisten in the bright sunshine. I am walking on snowshoes through Paradise, on cloud 9! Whoever would have thought?!


